Bogota Recycling Calendar 2012



January through June, 2012

Dear Bogota Friend and Neighbor:

The Mayor and Council hope that in this Holiday Season you and your family find peace, comfort and hope as the New Year approaches.

I am sending to you this calendar of the exciting changes coming to our town based on the new bid for collection of household waste, recycling and vegetative waste.

The changes are explained on this 2012 calendar and on the back page. First and foremost I want you to know the 3-year contract authorized by your Governing Body reduces the costs of collection of these materials by over \$250,000 during the life of the contract. In addition, we would no longer rely on Bogota's DPW fleet in this capacity, resulting in savings on insurance, gasoline and manpower, which shall further reduce our costs above the \$250,000 savings, previously mentioned.

On January 1, 2012, once the new contract starts, we will have a revised schedule of collection for household waste. In cooler months the trash shall be picked up once a week, but the pickup shall include bulky waste which was formerly picked up only once a month during months that did not interfere with leaf collection or snow removal. Now, each and every pickup allows for bulky waste - chairs, sofas and convertible sofas (without the bed frame) and like kind items.

Also note, the new contractor shall pick up recycling as previously collected. Thank you for your hard work on recycling, it has made these savings possible. What is new is that the new contractor shall pick up yard waste, (grass clippings) removing this as a function of the DPW.

Again, the new contract saves us money and frees the DPW from collecting these materials, thus freeing them up for other projects which have been either done on a hit or miss basis or sent out for others to do, which resulted in the Borough incurring more costs.

To sum this up, all of this is possible, *the savings in future budgets, reduced wear and tare on the DPW fleet and freeing up the DPW to perform vital tasks that now we can do ourselves*, due to all of your efforts to increase recycling. It shows recycling can save big and Bogota has proved it. Thank you again.
