Bond Ordinance for Improvements to Storm and Sanitary Sewers in the Amount of \$350,000"

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE UNDERTAKING OF VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF BOGOTA, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$350,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bogota, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Bogota, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake various improvements to storm and sanitary sewers in, by and for said Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$350,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of

obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$350,000, and (4) \$17,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$333,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$75,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$17,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$17,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$333,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

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Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$333,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who

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is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of forty years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$333,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program

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as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

AUTHORIZING OFFICIAL TOWING COMPANIES FOR THE BOROUGH FOR THE THREE-YEAR PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2026 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2028

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bogota requires authorized towing companies to provide towing and recovery services within the Borough in accordance with Chapter 4, Section 12 of the Bogota Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough advertised for towing license applications for the three-year period from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2028 in The Record newspaper on September 14, 2025, in accordance with Borough ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the application deadline for submission of towing license applications was November 17, 2025 at 5:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, the following seven (7) companies submitted complete applications including all required documentation, hold harmless agreements, and necessary licenses and insurance certificates; and

WHEREAS, all applications have been reviewed by the Borough Clerk and the Chief of Police, and all applicants have been found to meet the requirements set forth in Ordinance No. 1384 and Ordinance No. 1530, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has approved all seven applicants and recommends their authorization as official towing companies for the Borough of Bogota; and

WHEREAS, all fees charged by these authorized towing companies shall be in accordance with the fee schedule established in Section 4-12.10 of Chapter 4 of the Bogota Code, as amended by Ordinance No. 1530:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bogota, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION OF OFFICIAL TOWING COMPANIES

The following seven (7) companies are hereby authorized and approved as official towing companies for the Borough of Bogota for the three-year period commencing January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2028:

- 1. A & D TOWING AND RECOVERY, LLC
- 2. ALL POINTS AUTO AND TOWING INC
- 3. BERGEN BROOKSIDE TOWING CORP
- 4. COURTHOUSE AUTO BODY

SECTION 2: TERMS AND CONDITIONS All authorized towing companies shall operate in accordance with:

- a. Chapter 4, Section 12 of the Bogota Code;
- b. Ordinance No. 1384 and Ordinance No. 1530, as amended;
- c. The fee schedule established in Section 4-12.10 of Chapter 4;
- d. All applicable State of New Jersey laws and regulations governing towing operations;
- e. The terms and conditions set forth in their respective applications and hold harmless agreements.

SECTION 3: FEE COMPLIANCE

All authorized towing companies shall charge fees in strict accordance with the maximum fee schedule established in Section 4-12.10 of Chapter 4 of the Bogota Code. No fees shall be charged that are not set forth in said fee schedule, nor shall any charges exceed the maximum amounts established therein.

SECTION 4: ROTATION AND DISPATCH

The Chief of Police or his designee shall establish and maintain a rotation system for dispatching authorized towing companies in accordance with Borough ordinances and standard operating procedures.

SECTION 5: REVOCATION

The Mayor and Council reserve the right to revoke the authorization of any towing company that fails to comply with Borough ordinances, State laws, or the terms and conditions of their authorization.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution shall take effect on January 1, 2026.

Dear Fund Commissioner:

The South Bergen Municipal Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) is in its 39th year of operation and it continues to be one of the most successful shared service programs for public entities in the history of the State of New Jersey. Bogota has been a member of this program since 1/1/1986, and Bogota's membership in the South Bergen Municipal Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) is scheduled to renew on January 1, 2026.

REMARKABLE RESULTS

The South Bergen Municipal JIF has a strong balance sheet in the MEL system, with a statutory surplus in excess of over \$6.4 million. The Fund's success has allowed for dividends to be issued to our members since 1990. While dividends are not guaranteed, the South Bergen JIF has issued over \$25.5 million in dividends to its members.

When you are conducting your due diligence to ensure the best deal for your taxpayers, make sure you are comparing 'apples to apples' on the terms of the coverage being offered. Ask, "<u>Does the insurer publicly share current surplus numbers and paid annual dividends?</u>" Also, take a careful look at the insurer's financial records and balance sheet to ensure you are not potentially saddling your taxpayers with a liability which could take the form of an additional assessments in the near future.

CHALLENGING FINANCIAL LANDSCAPE- 'Perfect Storm'

In the current environment, as public entities struggle with budget constraints, the South Bergen JIF will continue to diligently pursue fiscal responsibility and maintain member cost stability with a sustainable coverage platform and a strong safety and loss control program.

That said, it is anticipated that 2026 will continue to present all municipalities with unique challenges resulting from significant exposure and legislative changes, including:

- Extension of the Statute of Limitations for Sexual Abuse Claims (S-477) affecting liability costs.
- The Cancer Presumption bill for first responders (A-1741) affecting workers compensation costs.
- Changes in the coordination between workers' compensation claims and the NJ pension system (Pension offset).
- The impact of COVID claims on workers' compensation costs
- Erosion of Title 59 immunities/social inflation.
- Local, National and Global property disasters affecting property costs.
- Supply chain issues and labor shortages affecting property costs.
- Cyber claims and coverage.

While we expect these changes will have a significant impact on local municipal and JIF budgets statewide, the South Bergen JIF will help our members navigate through this challenging and ever-changing landscape.

LEADERSHIP

In summary, the South Bergen JIF is well positioned to respond to the evolving needs of the 23 municipalities it serves here in southern Bergen County. The financial stability of the South Bergen JIF has been the result of a relentless emphasis on safety training, effective risk management, responsive coverage, and the personal involvement of your peers, both here locally, and the leaders of the 19 Joint Insurance Funds statewide, whom together form the MEL/JIF system. One of the major keys to your Fund's local success is its broad member involvement, including understanding how the South Bergen JIF functions, and understanding the value of your participation in its management. South Bergen JIF membership retention efforts have been remarkably successful, and the dedication of your JIF Fund Commissioners has made your JIF a resounding success. Now, more than ever, it is important that our members stay involved. If you would like to be a part of the management and the success of the South Bergen JIF, please contact me. We welcome involvement from all Fund Commissioners and member municipalities.
