## Poll Worker Requirements:

- United States citizen and a resident of New Jersey.
- You must be registered to vote in Bergen County to be a poll worker. **Note:** Those under 21 years of age will work limited hours per shift and do not have to be registered to vote.
- *Voter Registration Deadline – October 17, 2023.*
- Minimum Age: 16-year-old. College and high school students are encouraged to apply.
- Attend training sessions to prepare for your role. (see dates above)
- Fill out - Poll worker application for appointment


