RE: DOG LICENSE REQUIRED – N.J. STATE LAW: N.J.S.A. § 4:19-15.2

ATTN: Dog owners residing in Bogota, NJ 07603

Any person who shall own, keep or harbor a dog shall annually, in the month of January must apply for a license and official metal registration tag **for each dog they** own in the municipality in which they reside.

In order to obtain a Borough License for your dog(s) you will need to:

1. Submit proof of rabies vaccine from a NJ Licensed Veterinarian.
 - a. The Rabies Vaccine must be valid through October 31 of the licensing year.**
2. Submit proof of Spading/Neutering for dog(s) receiving their first Borough Dog License.
3. Complete and submit the application below to obtain a Dog License/Tag.

The Borough of Bogota will host a Free Rabies Clinic on **March 18, 2023 from 10AM – 12PM at the W. Broad Street Fire House – Located next to the Bogota Police Department**
