Instructions to apply for a marriage license

- Complete the marriage license application form and schedule an appointment to submit it
- The couple and 1 witness of at least 18 years of age must be appear at the appointment
- Proof of identity by presenting your driver's license, passport or state/federal I.D.
- Proof of residency by one applicant if a NJ resident
- The \$28 application fee ****\$28 fee is now being waived for marriage license applications, effective July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023****

After you apply

- There is a 72-hour waiting period before the license is issued. The waiting period begins when the application is filed with the Local Registrar.
- There is no 72-hour waiting period for a remarriage; however, you must bring a certified copy of your existing marriage.
- The marriage license application is valid for six (6) months from the date accepted.
- License is valid for 30 days from date of issue.

Wedding Ceremony Information

- Wedding ceremonies must be scheduled in advanced.
- The Judge of the Municipal Court in Little Ferry, NJ performs wedding ceremonies free of charge. To schedule a wedding ceremony in Little Ferry, please call: 201-440-2111
